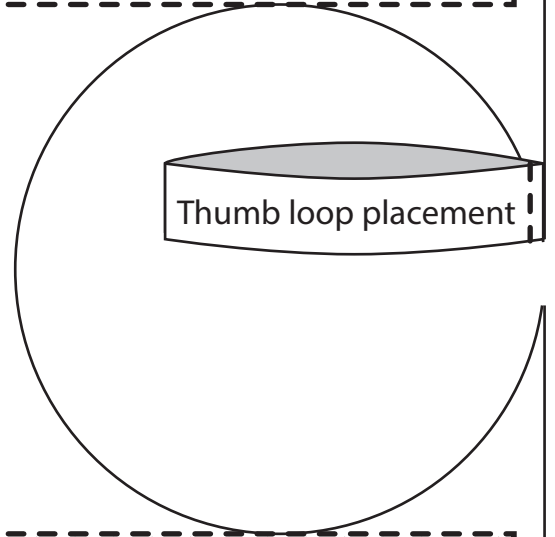




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cut x1 pair in scuba

# Plein Air Painting Gloves Sewing Instructions

1. Cut out x1 pair in scuba fabric with 30% stretch.
2. Cut x4 7cm pieces of hook Velcrose.
3. Cut x2 10cm pieces of elastic - I used \*FOE as it is soft. \* Fold over elastic
4. Attach the Velcrose in the position as marked on the pattern.
5. Fold the gloves in half with the Velcrose on the outside.
6. Fold the elastic in half and pin to the glove in the position shown on the pattern.
7. Sew down the side seam. You can use a straight stitch, overlocking, or hand sew with a blanket stitch. Note: scuba fabric does not fray so doesn't need 'finishing'.
8. Optional: overlock the finger and wrist opening.
